


# OLD REPORT CARD vs. NEW REPORT CARD

## HOW ARE THEY ALIKE?


- On-line
- Outcome based
- Attendance is automatically generated from Maplewood
- Personalized comments can be entered
- Part of a reporting system (report card, interim report (if applicable) and student/parent/teacher conferences)
- Can be printed on any size of paper

## HOW ARE THEY DIFFERENT?



- Some teachers used grade books that were not integrated with the on-line report card


### Grade Book



- An integrated grade book is included
- Teachers will enter their assignments into the system
- You can indicate whether your assessment is summative, formative, diagnostic or other
- You can indicate whether your assignment is a product, observation or a conversation
- Teachers still assess based on outcomes. The software calculates a mark for each strand based on the marks that have been entered into the grade book using most consistent and most recent and average as formulas.
- Color coding in the grade book matches our benchmarks
- Once you have entered the marks into the grade book it will automatically generate your report card mark.
- There is no need to use other electronic grade books
- You can generate various graphs and interim reports from the grade book
- Teacher's professional judgment can be applied to the final mark for each strand


### Support



- Created by an outside organization, Students Achieve with direction from SRSD
- The Integrated Learning department will provide support and training
- Other school divisions across Canada are using this program

- Optional letter grade OR percentage grade
- 1, 2, 3, 4 were entered with 1 being excellent
- Personalized comments and/or comment bank was used

### Achievement



- Only 1, 2, 3, 4 can be entered as a mark for each outcome which rolls up to a mark for each strand. There is no overall course mark.
  - 4 – Mastery
  - 3 – Proficiency
  - 2 – Approaching
  - 1 – Beginning
- No letter grade or percentage can be entered
- You can include formative and summative assessments in your grade book with only the summative assessments being reported upon in the report card
- Comments are additionally titled 'Strengths/Areas for Improvement/Next Steps' to keep the focus on outcomes based comments.
