



## Proposed Tier 1 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

**Tier 1** Core intervention, typically appropriate for 80% of the student population

- Graphic organizers
- Cloze activities (e.g. for note-taking)
- Study Buddies
- Highlighters
- Different fonts in Microsoft Word (e.g., ASL sign language font)
- Mnemonic strategies
- Test-taking practice

## Proposed Tier 2 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

**Tier 2** Targeted intervention, where 15% of the students will be placed

**Includes all Tier1 strategies listed above**

- Digital recorder
- Photocopies of teacher or students' notes
- Tablet or slantboard for writing or sketching
- Smartpen
- Livescribe pen

  - Educreations app
  - Showme app

### Proposed Tier 3 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

**Tier 3** Intensive intervention, required for approximately 5% of the student population

Includes all Tier1 and Tier2 strategies listed above; and needed by the student on a continuous basis

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
