

Proposed Tier 1 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

Tier 1 Core intervention, typically appropriate for 80% of the student population

- Graphic organizers
- Cloze activities (e.g. for note-taking)
- Study Buddies
- Highliters
- Different fonts in Microsoft Word (e.g., ASL sign language font)
- Mneumonic strategies
- Test-taking practice

Proposed Tier 2 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

Tier 2 Targeted intervention, where 15% of the students will be placed

Includes all Tier1 strategies listed above

- Photocopies of teacher or students' notes
- Tablet or slantboard for writing or sketching
- Smartpen
- Livescribe pen
- Ipad apps
 - Audionote app
 - Educreations app

Proposed Tier 3 AT for Study Tools/Note taking

Tier 3 Intensive intervention, required for approximately 5% of the student population

Includes all Tier1 and Tier2 strategies listed above; and needed by the student on a continuous basis
